Mr Isogai emphasized his main focus on "Be Ambitious, Be Global". He talked about management principles contributed by Chankya. Few Japanese management principles like KAIZEN, 5S etc were shared by him. Finally, he persuaded to develop an insight on eleven articles designed by him. In the next lecture followed by Mr Saripalli focused on personality development. He shared a Japanese management principle IKIGAI i.e A reason for being.
