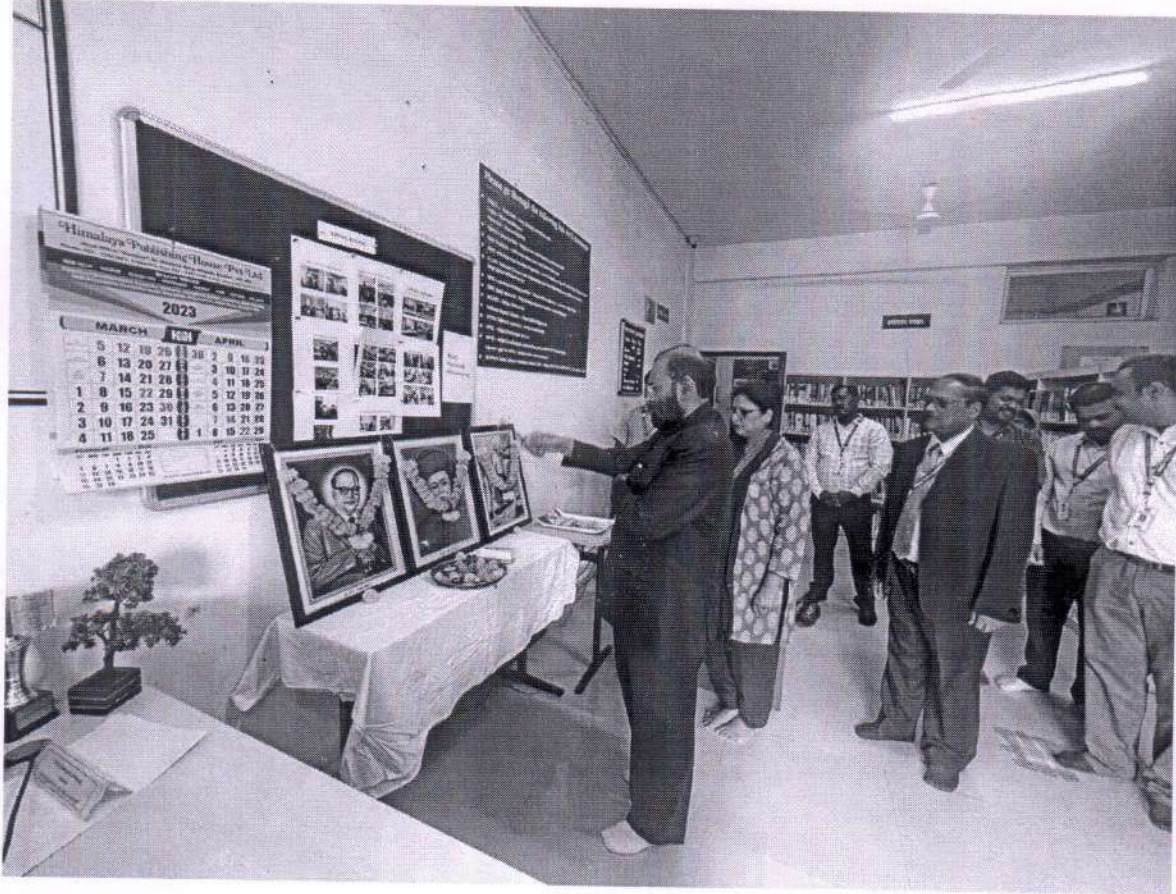
Republic Day
