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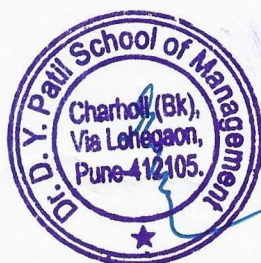

1. Objectives

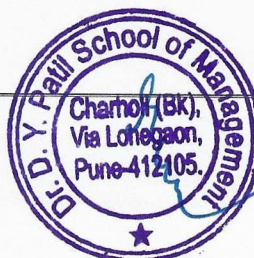
- To promote a sense of community, compassion and raise awareness about the challenges faced by the elderly and underprivileged children.

- To interact with the residents, engage them in activities, and provide them with companionship and support.

2. Context:

- In the pursuit of its commitment to community welfare, DYPSON organized visits to various old age homes, ashrams, schools. The initiative aimed to alleviate some of the challenges faced by the elderly residents, children and the people in the society. By providing essential items, DYPSON sought to make a meaningful impact on their lives, offering awareness, comfort and realization of the issues and the ways to tackle them.
- The social visits were organized by the faculties with volunteering students from DYPSON. The team consisted of individuals from diverse backgrounds, including students, professionals, and retirees. the children through educational activities, storytelling, and games shed light on their dreams, aspirations, and the resilience they exhibited despite their challenging circumstances.

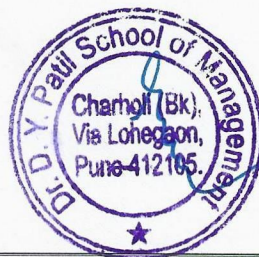
- The visit provided the residents with food, fruits, blankets, companionship, and support.

Objectives of the program:

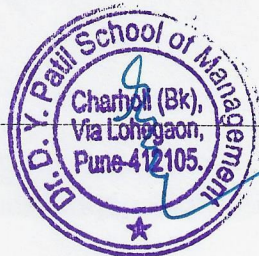

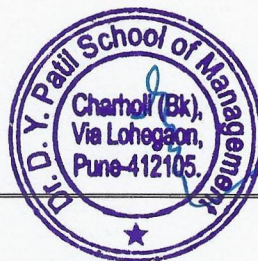




Program Outcomes: -

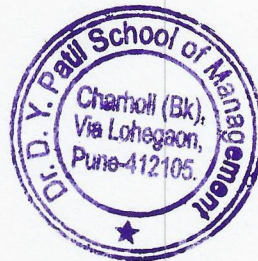

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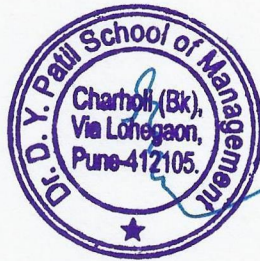

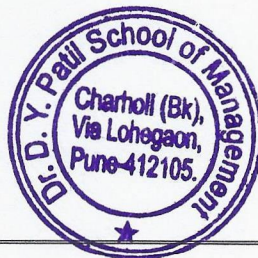

Introduction:

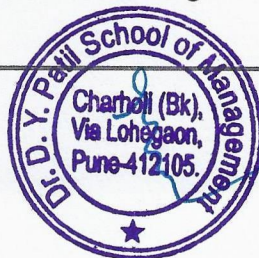

Program Details:

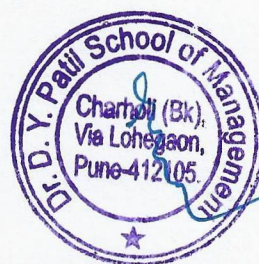
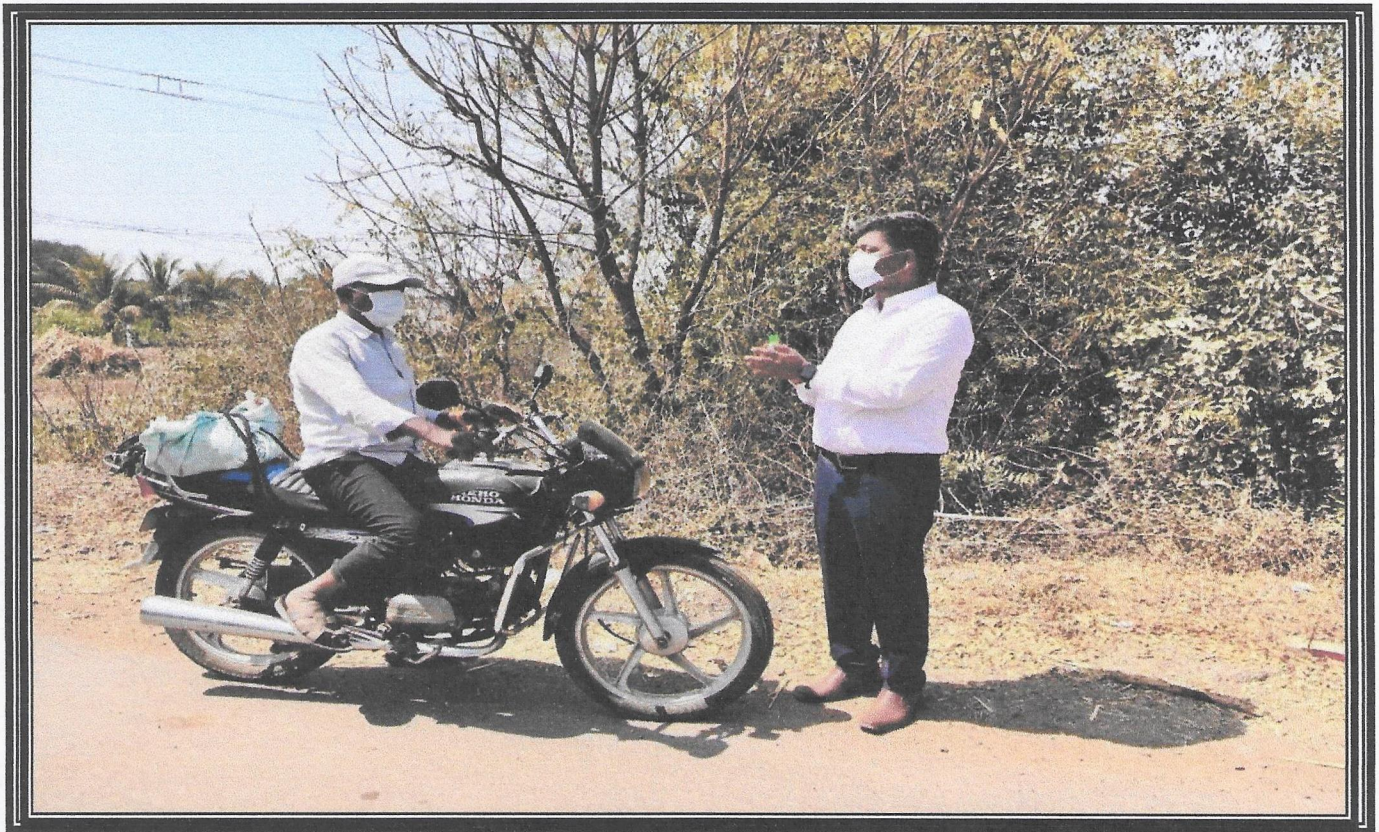

Program Outcomes:

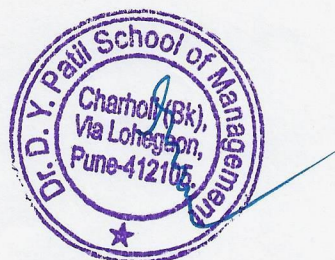
- 1. Increased Awareness:** The event successfully raised awareness among students about the significance of wearing masks as a preventive measure against the transmission of diseases.

The primary objective was to contribute to the well-being of the Warkari community by providing nutritious and wholesome meals during their pilgrimage.

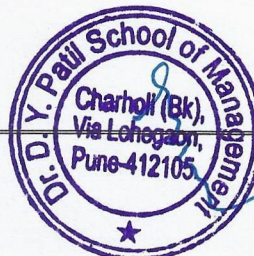

3. The practice:

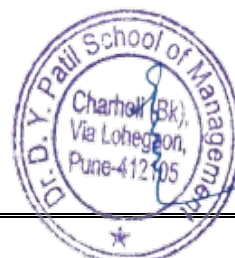
