Following points were discussed as per the meeting agenda:


Dr. E. B. Khedkar Sir expressed warm welcome to all the IQAC Committee members for attending the meeting and the proceedings were started.

Agenda 3: One Day Workshop on Fire Safety Awareness & Demonstration.

Resolution: A Workshop on Fire safety Awareness and Demonstration was organised by Dr D Y Patil School of Management, Lohegaon, Pune on 15th January 2020. The objective of the workshop was to create awareness about fire safety amongst the students of MBA, teaching and non-teaching staff of the institute.

The workshop was organized in association with Safe Kids Foundation, Pune. Mr. Milind Gudade, Programme Associate, Safe Kids Foundation and Mr. Ram Sathe, Fire Coordinator, Safe Kids Foundation guided the students and staff.

The students were made to understand the escape plan and practice for moving through escape routes. They were told that the purpose of this information was to establish a systematic, safe and orderly evacuation of students, teachers and other staff members from the affected area to safety.

The Students were guided to follow the instructions given below:

- 1. Raising the Alarm Any Student discovering an outbreak of fire should raise an alarm to notify others. This can be done by shouting 'Fire Fire' or sounding of bell.
- 2. Local Fire brigade shall immediately be informed over 101.
- Ambulance shall immediately be informed over 108.
- 4. Students should come out in proper line and not create any noise or panic.
- 5. Teachers have to come out and head count /roll calls are to be conducted.
- 6. No overtaking, running, shouting laughing shall be allowed.
- 7. Keep Fire extinguisher in working condition at your home and school.
- 8. Information about basic causes of fire and types of fire was given.
- 9. Information about avoiding fire incidences at home was delivered.
- 10. Never stand up. Always Crawl low on the ground and keep your face covered.

11. Do not Run – Roll over ground to put off the fire.

After instructions about fire safety live demonstration for using Fire safety instruments and equipment was provided by the members of Safe Kids Foundation. They have explained and discussed some fire cases and the reasons behind the incidence.

Faculty members and students have actively participated in the demonstration on field. 15 teaching and non-teaching staff members and 46 students were present for the workshop.
