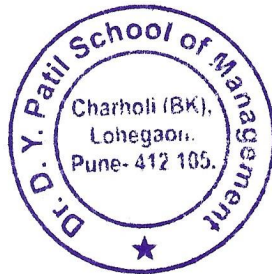

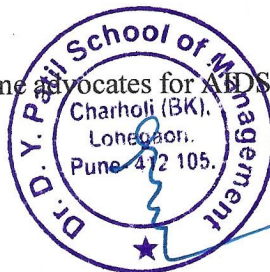

The Empowering Community: HIV Prevention & Education initiative was launched with the goal of raising awareness, providing education, and promoting preventive measures against HIV within our community. 5. To encourage students to become advocates for AIDS awareness in their communities.

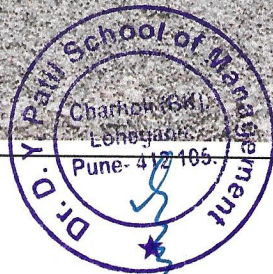


Details of the Program:

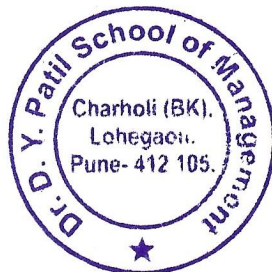

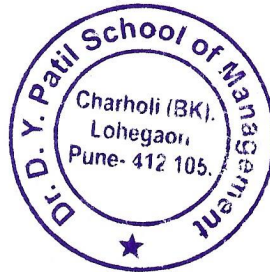

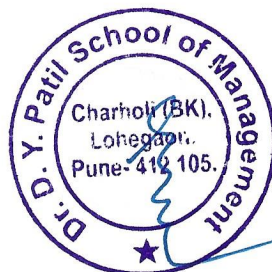

5. Raise awareness about the significance of supporting labourers in society.





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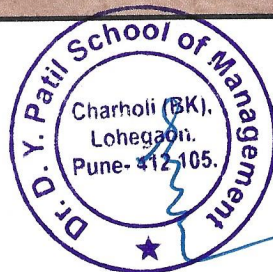

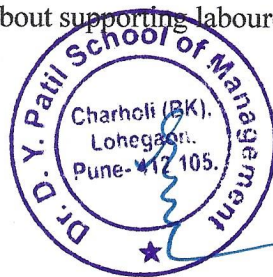


Dhannya Distribution to Labour Society at Dhanori

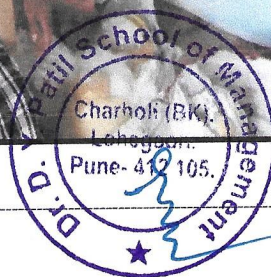

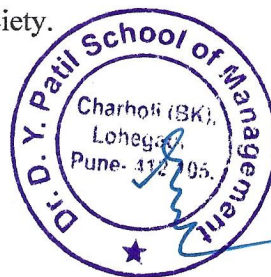

INTRODUCTION:

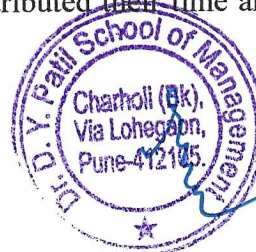

4. To foster a community support system for families of laborers, enhancing their overall well-being.



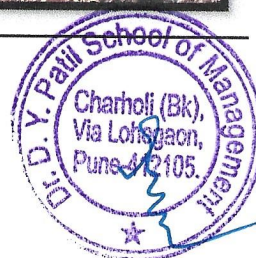
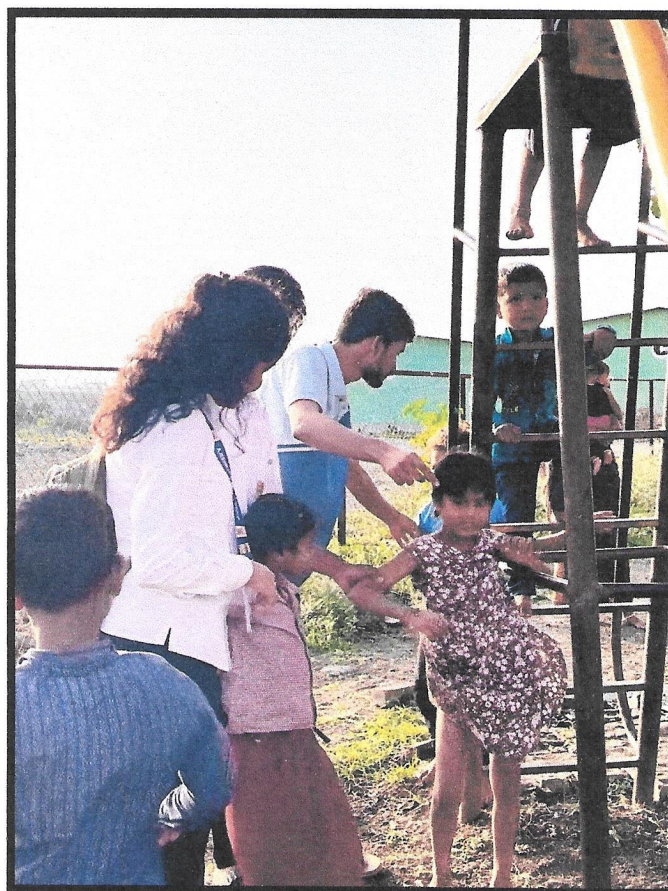


Details of the program with photographs:

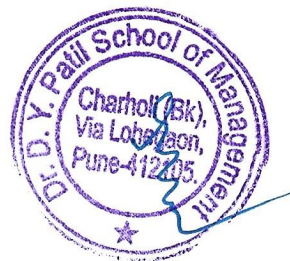

- To address cultural norms and stereotypes that perpetuate discrimination against girls.

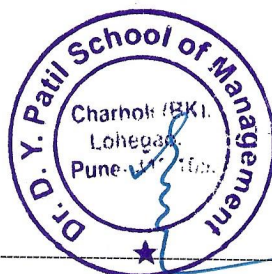


Details of the Program:

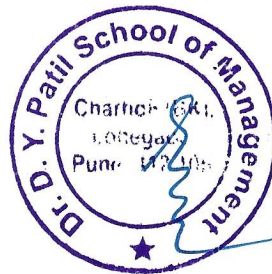


Program Outcomes:

4. Encouraging personal growth: Supporting the development of self-awareness, self-discipline, and self-reflection.

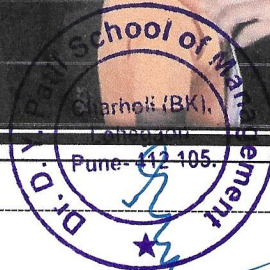
